Is [Arise Home Education](#) a school?

No. Arise Home Education is not a school. However, we partner with Christian home educators to facilitate learning by offering live online classes and self-directed courses with tutors specialising in a variety of subjects for UK exam prep as private candidates and/or [US qualifications](#).

How many days per week do live sessions meet?

Live classes for up to 80 minutes once a week (Mon-Fri) where tutors and students participate in learning about a particular subject based on the course(s) purchased. In some cases, students will meet for one or two 40 minute sessions. This will be indicated on the course description in the [shop](#).

How many hours per day should be dedicated to independent learning/homework?

In addition to the live sessions, tutors will set weekly homework. In general, students can expect 30 min. to 1 hr a day of additional learning activities/homework. For a total of roughly 3.5-5 hours of learning per online class per week.

If I want to register my student, how much would it cost per year?

Registration is on a per class basis. Prices are indicated on the course description of each class. In general, most of our classes are 30 week classes for secondary aged students (11-18 year olds). For multiple classes there are [bundle](#) discounts. Parents and students choose course(s) based on the home educating needs of the student and their family.

What subjects do you offer for 11-13 year olds?

At Arise Home Education, our [lower secondary classes](#) for students 11-13, provide a solid foundation for more focused learning in the upper secondary years. Core 4 courses in Maths, English Language, Science and Socials Studies, plus additional courses in Bible, Logic, foreign language, art, and more, offer a well-rounded approach to home learning. Choose one class or organise a complete timetable.

What subjects do you offer for 14+?

At Arise Home Education, our [upper secondary classes](#) (14+) provide more focused learning based on academic and future goals. Core 4 courses for the upper secondary years include Maths, English Language, Science and Social Studies, plus additional courses in Bible, apologetics, foreign language, art, and more. These courses offer qualifications-based

learning for students preparing to sit UK exams as a private candidate or for US Qualifications (US High School diploma/transcript and SAT). Arise offers a well-rounded approach to home learning that prepares students for college, university acceptance, and more. Choose one class or organise a complete timetable for iGCSE and AS/A-level or enrichment courses that include Trinity College's [Arts Award](#) and [Speech & Drama](#) courses.

Do you offer Scottish Nat 5 or Higher courses?

We have a growing number of Scottish courses for students that wish to sit these exams as private candidates at a local, approved exam centre. It is up to parents to secure an exam centre, and we recommend knowing where this will be prior to purchasing.

What are the admission requirements for Arise Home Education?

Arise Home Education offers online classes with a Christ-centred worldview emphasis. As such, prospective students, parents, and tutors are asked learn about [who we are](#) by reviewing our [statement of faith](#), [student honour code](#) and [Parent/Student Guide](#) to ensure they are able to accept or respect the learning style and approach unique to Arise Home Education as we partner with Christian families in their home education journey.
